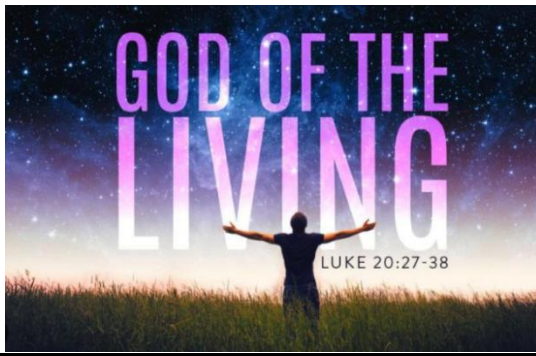




St Peter's Church

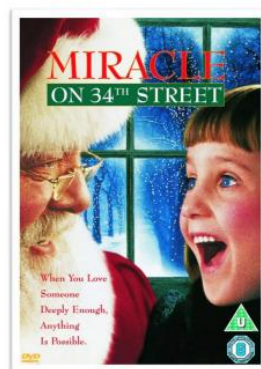


The Food Bank will be open on **21st November** from 11:30 am to 12:30 pm at Trinity Methodist Church.
