The Church of England's Advent and Christmas theme for 2025 revolves round a single word: Joy!

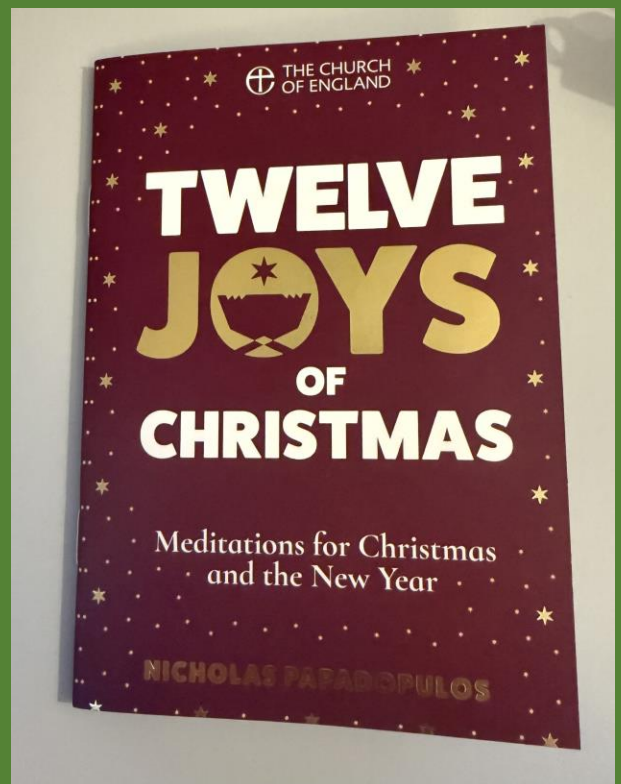


Our churches and cathedrals will - as always - be seeking to make the most of the opportunity December brings to share *The Joy of Christmas* with their communities.

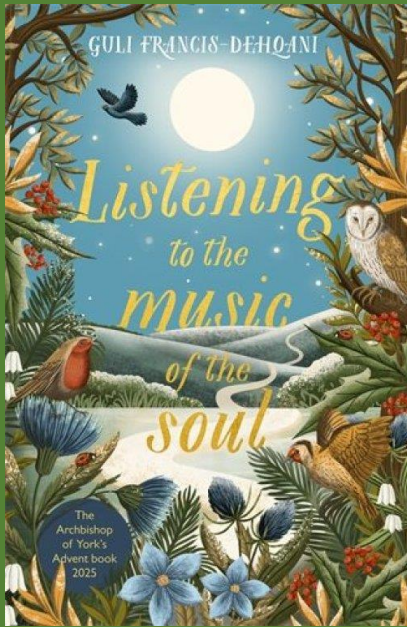
