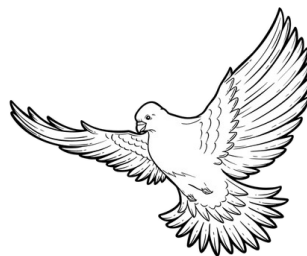
Stay with us, Lord, in the devastating

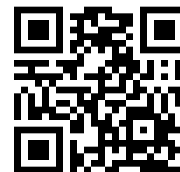
