and peace in our hearts:

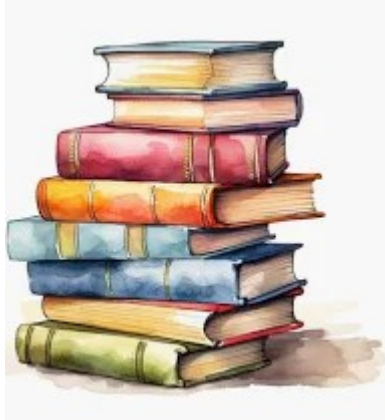
through thy Son our Saviour Jesus Christ.
