Sharing Hot Chocolate and sweets outside St Johns and St Albans

Today we celebrate All Saints Day - Ephesians 1.11-23 & Luke 6.20-31

All Saints' celebrates the great company of faithful people—past and present—who reflect God's light in the world. Paul reminds us in Ephesians that we share a glorious inheritance as God's people, joined together in Christ who rules over all things. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus turns our ideas of success upside down: *Blessed are the poor, the hungry, the sorrowful*, he says, because God's kingdom belongs to them. All Saints' invites us to live as people of that kingdom—marked not by power or wealth, but by compassion, mercy, and love. We remember those who have shown us what holiness looks like in everyday life, and we give thanks that we too are called to be saints.

Some things to ponder

- How do Jesus' blessings for the poor and the hungry in *Luke 6* challenge our ideas of success?
- Who has been a "saint" in your life—someone whose faith and love have drawn you closer to God?
