


Advent encourages waiting in hope, courageous peace-making, resilient joy, and self-giving love amidst our suffering in a wounded world.

Advent & Christmas Services at St Aidan's Church












The angel said to them, 'Do not be afraid; for see – I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people...' – Luke 2.10-11
