It is based on the idea of the festival of Las Posadas, celebrated chiefly in Mexico. The tradition reminds us of the journey that Mary and Joseph made looking for shelter in Bethlehem before baby Jesus was born. The festival is called Las Posadas, because the word "posada" means "inn" in Spanish. Mary and Joseph knock on the doors of all the inns in the town, searching for shelter, before finally finding somewhere to stay. We hope our crib will enjoy its travels and helps create some opportunities for conversation and reflection in Advent.
