

A word for the week

"Words! Words! Words! I'm so sick of words!" Eliza Doolittle sings in "My Fair Lady." We ourselves often say, "Talk is cheap." God's word, however, always bears meaning and power. God's word (Hebrew: dabar) is always active and effective: God speaks, and David is promised a kingdom that is to endure forever; God speaks, and the Word is made flesh.

God's word surprised both David and Mary, announcing a much greater future than they envisioned not only for themselves but for the whole world. God announces to David through the prophet Nathan that God's house is to be a holy people who will "endure forever" rather than a temple. God announces to Mary through Gabriel that the Infant she will conceive will be no ordinary Child, but "the Son of God." God's word always calls us to new possibilities and new life.

A word about new possibilities for our lives raises two challenges for us: first, discerning whether the word we hear is in fact from God and God's will for us; second, having the courage to say Yes, if it is.
