CHRISTMAS MESSAGE FROM THE VICAR

Some of you may have seen that Heeley Parish Church was featured on ITV Calendar news this week. It was part of a piece on Blue Christmas services, which provide a space during the season for those grieving the loss of someone they love.

I was initially asked if they could have a few shots of me pretending to put out hymn books – a bit difficult, when we don't have hymn books, or pews to put them in! So instead, they filmed me pretending to light the Advent candles.

There is always some artifice to our media-driven world. We curate the photos we put on Instagram, Snapchat, or Facebook, so that they convey the image we want to portray of ourselves. We use filters to make ourselves look a particular way. But under it all, we long for authenticity. It's no surprise that many young people today are abandoning social media, and prefer to find friendships through shared interests.

It constantly amazes me that there was no artifice in God becoming a human being in Jesus. That he became a real live baby, who needed feeding and changing and was completely reliant for survival on his parents. And as he grew, Jesus felt things just like us – the Gospels tell us how he was tired, and thirsty, and cried.

Throughout history, some people have found this offensive – how could God, the creator of the universe, become really human? But this is the truth – this is the God we worship – one who never made creation to be far and distant from himself, but who wanted to come to us, to be with us, and to be one of us, so that we could never be in any doubt that he understands and loves us.

I hope you may find the comfort of his presence with you, especially if you are feeling sad or lonely for any reason. I wish you every blessing of this Christmas season! All are very welcome at any of our remaining Christmas services.
