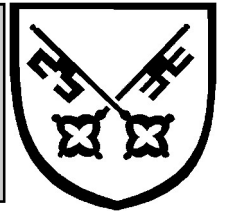


Welcome to St Peter's Sunday 7th December 2nd Sunday of Advent

Your Regular donations to St Peters

Thank you to those of you who
have already told me you have
switched you standing Orders.

For clarification, if you make a
regular payment to St Peters, then
this does affect you. The reference
to HSBC is our receiving bank, not
where you bank.

I have been asked why this has
become a problem. The reason its
become hard to manage HSBC is
because they require most
transactions to be online, but as a
charity we need to have dual
authorisation for payments. But
any online access with HSBC
automatically allows single
authorisation payments.

The alternative are:

1. The Parish Giving Scheme is the
simplest, through their website
www.parishgiving.org.uk and
search Parishes for St Peters Didcot
or call them on 0333 002 1271

2. For Barclays, you can set up a
new standing order from your
account, payable to:
PCC St Peters; 20-01-09;
00691267

Don't forget to cancel your existing
standing order to the HSBC
account after making the switch!
Or put in a one off donation if you
cancel before the new SO starts.
