Building Works in our Churches Holy Trinity reopened with new lighting at a special service last week! Sadly during the works we have realised that the roof in the south aisle is dangerous and in urgent need of repair. We have estimated that the repair will cost about £20,000, but the whole roof in the south aisle will need to be repaired in the near future with a cost of about £150,000. **As a result, we have had to cordon off the south transept until the urgent repair is done.** This will mean the organ can't be played, but we will still be able to have Advent and Christmas! We will publish more details over the coming weeks once we have the architect and engineer reports.
