Martin was a much-loved member of the Christ Church congregation for many years, was church warden from 2002-2005 and was also chair of the Old Town Partnership of Churches 2006- 2009. Daniel Pitt writes: 'Martin's leadership, wisdom, kindness and grace are some of his qualities that will be remembered. He set a high bar in his leadership roles.

In addition to his many roles at - and outside - Christ Church with St Mary's, Martin was a regular member at Men's Breakfast, where on many occasions he courageously shared very personal issues, including depression, which affects many. Martin spoke, and wrote, directly and with compassion.

Outside his demanding professional life, Martin was also an assessor for the Duke of Edinburgh Scheme, including Gold - another challenging role.'
