Dear Friends of St Faith's,

I hope this letter finds you well and enjoying this season of Advent. As we begin a new year in the life of the Church, I'm writing to ask whether you might prayerfully consider supporting our parish as we undertake some much-needed works on our building.

The Lady Chapel lies at the east end of the church, and can be seen through the vertical wooden beams above the high altar. It is a beautiful and vital space for us as a church. All our weekday Masses and daily offices take place there, and the sacrament is reserved there. It is also the place where the Altar of Repose is arranged on Maundy Thursday. I often think of it as the church's "engine room" – a small, somewhat hidden space that powers the whole life of the parish.

With the passing of time, the chapel's fabric has aged and now requires careful restoration. As a PCC we recently agreed to have the walls cleaned and repainted, and I'm pleased that this work has already begun. We hope that the renewed chapel will once again feel like a place of calm beauty and prayer for all who enter.

As you will know, such work is never inexpensive, and we expect to spend around £6,000 on the project. I'm writing to ask whether you would consider making a donation to help us meet these costs, and to ensure that this important space for our parish community can continue to be used to the greater glory of God.
