# A LETTER FROM GRACE

My dear friends,

On Remembrance Sunday last year (I am writing this in 2025), the journalist, Alison Pearson, was visited by two police officers who told her that she had been reported for a non-crime hate incident.

She asked what it was she had said, or written, but they said they couldn't tell her.

She asked who her accuser was. Not only was she told that they couldn't tell her but said that she mustn't refer to the person as the "accuser" but as the "victim".

What happened to innocent until proved guilty?

When she wrote an article about it, she had a lot of support, but she was nevertheless very upset. Shortly after the article appeared, she took a taxi in London. When she got out, the taxi driver looked at her and growled, "You that Alison Pearson?"

"Yes, I am," she replied, fearing the worst.

"No charge, love," he said, and drove off.

Now she was a well-paid journalist, probably on expenses, so the saving of the taxi fare meant very little to her, but this act of kindness meant a great deal.

We live in mad times at the moment, with wars and conflicts all over the world and acts of gratuitous violence in all countries, including our own. Even the law seems to have gone pear-shaped. It seems to me that small acts of kindness in these times are more important than ever.

Jesus never gave us the idea that things were going to get better. In fact, He warned us that the world, if anything, would get worse. He said that there would be wars, famines and earthquakes.

However, He also said, "Believe Me, anyone who gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones, just because he is My disciple, will by no means lose his reward."

So there we have it, small acts of kindness.

So as we travel into 2026, we would like the world in general to improve, but even if it doesn't, we should still take the opportunity to do small acts of kindness, because in that way, we can make the world close to us a better place, and it is a way of showing that we are Jesus's disciples.



# DAN'S NEXT STEPS

## 29 November

Dan made his very first outing last weekend, to the coffee morning at Holy Trinity Church. He had a fab time, and he caught up with friends, old and new. Thank you to Rev. Tracy and everyone for making ourselves and Dan so welcome.

## 01 December

Dan made his second outing last weekend, to the Christmas fayre at Freckleton Methodist Church, with great stalls selling Christmas bits. He again had a fab time, and he caught up with friends old and new. Thank you to Deacon Kim Gabbatiss and everyone for making ourselves and Dan so welcome.

We were hoping to get to St Paul's for their Christmas fayre on the same day, but unfortunately, Dan was too tired by then.

It's always busy for Dan with medical appointments. He was back at Royal Manchester Children's Hospital for his regular MRI scan, to check that his brain tumour is still responding to the marathon of chemotherapy he endured, which was 78 weeks in total. His shunt is also checked.

Dan is getting stronger day by day now he's home. This time, he managed to stay still in the MRI scanner for an hour and did not need to be sedated by general anaesthetic. This is a massive milestone for him, as he managed to control his dystonia, which has always got the better of him in the past.

## 05 December

Dan had a lovely evening at the lighting of the Christmas tree in the village. We used to go every year before Dan became ill. It was fantastic to see it so well supported by everyone.

## 12 December

Last weekend, Dan was out and about and managed to go to St Paul's coffee morning. Fab sausage barms, and lots of cake and coffee. Thank you to everyone who made us feel so welcome. Dan also had a catch-up with Trish Wood, whose grandson went to school with him.

## 14 December

A great big thank you to Freckleton Band for making time to come to play for Dan. It was really kind to keep him in your thoughts. This really cheered up Dan, who has been suffering dystonic/epileptic episodes, which are being investigated at the moment by his new medical team. It was much appreciated – the joy it brought to his face.

Thank you to everyone at Love of the Glove. The love and support from the local boxing fans has been fantastic, and the local awareness generated and amounts raised have, and will, make a massive difference to Dan.

### **18 December**

It's only Thursday, and Dan's been very busy with Pear Tree School visiting him at home for lessons, and visits to Blackpool Victoria Hospital and Royal Manchester Children's Hospital. The great news is that the operation carried out at RMCH to rebuild his left foot has been a success, and it is healing very nicely. The surgeon is very pleased with progress. The good news just keeps on coming: the results from his disease development scan show his brain tumour is stable, with no changes. Dan has also had an EEG test carried out, to try and help diagnose his seizures/episodes, and we are waiting for the results. Onwards and upwards!

### **19 December**

It was hard to believe it was our first Christmas at home for three years with Dan.

Thank you to everyone who has supported our family and our Dan.

If you still want to help and support Dan, we'll be deeply thankful. There is no question that he would benefit from additional rehabilitation, therapies and equipment not readily available on the NHS.



### Infant nativities and junior carol concerts





As many of you will be aware, this autumn we have been appealing for support to rebuild the Life Christian School in India, which provides a quality Christian education to 200 children from rural communities.

The foundation work has been completed, and the pillars and plinths have been installed to form the ground floor of the building. Work has begun on the first floor, the slab work is in progress, and the plinth beams and pillars are being installed, which will form the first floor of the building.



Pictured below is Bhanu, a former student at the school. In August 2023, we shared his story of how the school has had a positive impact on his future. When he left school, he went to college to train as an electrician and plumber. This provides him with a steady income to provide for his family. He is married with two young daughters, who also attend the school. They are also part of the church family. Bhanu is assisting with the construction of the new school building.



We thank you for your generous donations that are helping to make all this possible. As we have shared previously, we estimate the rebuilding of the school will cost approximately £66,000, with ongoing running costs of approximately £24,000 per year to cover the cost of teaching and after-school provision.
