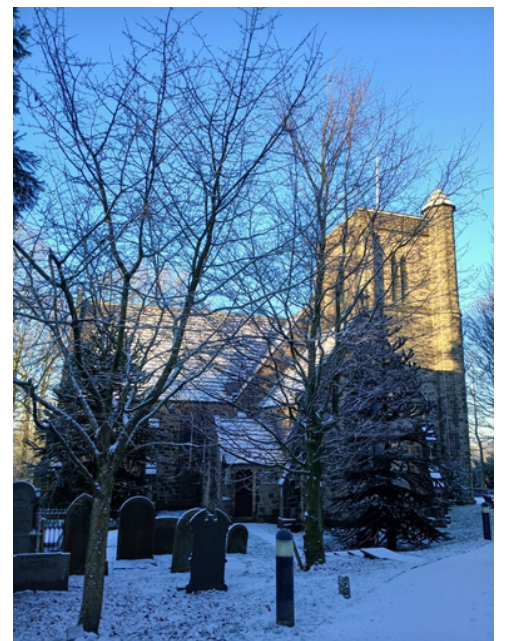

New YearNew Starts

The New year often brings a sense of hope and determination. I WILL do couch to 5k, I WILL be organised, eat better, not touch alcohol, eat lentils. I will NOT get frustrated, or say horrible things, I will think the best of everyone at all times..... I will try really hard and become a brilliant, better me

.... except for most of us that doesn't quite happen and by this time in January we have realised that it is not that simple.... and we have eaten our body weight in dairy milk and shouted at the cat. (Ok just me then!) You don't need to feel alone. Paul writing to the Romans chapter 7 has a similar feeling:

But I need something more! For if I know the law but still can't keep it, and if the power of sin within me keeps sabotaging my best intentions, I obviously need help! I realize that I don't have what it takes. I can will it, but I can't do it. I decide to do good, but I don't really do it; I decide not to do bad, but then I do it anyway. My decisions, such as they are, don't result in actions. Something has gone wrong deep within me and gets the better of me every time..²⁴ I've tried everything and nothing helps. I'm at the end of my rope. Is there no one who can do anything for me? Isn't that the real question?

The answer, thank God, is that Jesus Christ can and does. He acted to set things right in this life of contradictions where I want to serve God with all my heart and mind

.... A new power is in operation. With the arrival of Jesus, the Messiah, that fateful dilemma is resolved. Those who enter into Christ's being-here-for-us no longer have to live under a continuous, low-lying black cloud. The Spirit of life in Christ, like a strong wind, has magnificently cleared the air. (Message Bible)

So if you want to embrace a new start this year, embrace the journey of faith. Walk with King of Heaven each day, walk in the power of the Holy Spirit and with the love of the Father. I promise you God will transform you and your life. For some it will be dramatic 'the wind clears the air' and sets us on a new path; for others it will be slower lifting of the low-lying- cloud until our hearts burn with the fruits of the spirit; love, joy, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness and self control. Now that is proper transformation. That is what I am praying for this new year.
