

Notes from the Vicar....

Although by the beginning of February, Christmas may seem a distant memory, I wanted to say how much I've enjoyed my first Christmas with you - my estimate is that about 2000 people across the benefice engaged with our churches in one way or another over the season. That is a phenomenal number of people: it has been a joy to welcome you. DO come back - you're always welcome.

February 1st is the day when the church celebrates Candlemas – the time when we make a deliberate turning from Christmas and towards Lent. It's also the first half equinox of the year: halfway between the winter solstice and the spring equinox, the beginning of the end of winter: we might spot some early spring flowers and notice the days getting a bit longer.

It is a season of thresholds – a time to pause, look again, and step forward with intention. Candlemas, brings the Christmas season to its close and reminds us that the child of the manger is revealed as light for the world. The bible story tells us that when Mary and Joseph brought the baby to the Temple, he was recognised as the Messiah by both Simeon and Anna – both very old, holy people who lived in the Temple. Simeon's words which are remembered in the ancient prayer the *Nunc Dimittis* are both beautiful and challenging. The light that is Christ comforts, but also exposes; blesses, but also asks something of us. Candlemas gently turns our faces away from the crib and towards Lent.

Ash Wednesday and Lent

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, and we will be offering the traditional service with the imposition of ashes. Ashing can feel unfamiliar or even uncomfortable, so it's worth saying what it means. The ash – usually made from last year's palm crosses – is marked on the forehead with the words, "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return," or "Turn away from sin and be faithful to Christ." It is not about shame or judgement. It is a sign of honesty: about our mortality, our fragility, and our need of God's grace. Ash Wednesday reminds us that we begin Lent not by pretending to be strong, but by admitting that we are human. Our services of Holy Communion that day will be :

11.00am in Skelton Church

7.30pm in Armathwaite Church

Lent, the 40 days following Ash Wednesday, is often misunderstood as a gloomy or joyless season, but at its heart it is about honesty and hope. It is a time for taking faith seriously enough to ask questions, to notice habits we have slipped into, and to make space for God again.

This year, we are offering two groups during Lent to help us think about prayer: what it is, what it isn't, and how we might deepen or rediscover a prayer life that is realistic and sustaining. You don't need to be an expert, or even especially confident — just willing to come, listen, and reflect alongside others.

Alongside all this, I'm very aware that not everyone is able to be in church every week and that I am only able to be in each church once a month. To help with that, my sermons will be available from Mondays for anyone who would like to keep up with my preaching. They won't be in the public domain, but if you email the parish office, we can add you to a mailing list and send out a weekly link.

As Candlemas fades into Lent, we are reminded that faith is not static. It is something we carry, question, practise, and grow into. Wherever you find yourself this season — curious, committed, uncertain, or weary — you are very welcome to walk the road with us.

St Mary's Church, High Hesket

Happy New year everyone and a huge thank you to all who supported our fundraising events in 2025, we couldn't do it without you. Over the last 3 years we have carried out some major renovation work to future proof your church building. Inside of church cost £42,000 and the Bell Tower cost £10,000 and this year year we are hoping to start our final phase "The Vestry", which is very damp and starting to damage our archives and vestments. This is the oldest part of the Grade 2* listed building and the Diocese have advised us that to help get the vestry dry we need to chip off and replace all the internal lime plaster, replace door and window, chip off all the external concrete plaster which is trapping the moisture and replace with a more breathable Lime render, so our initial estimate has doubled!! We could not do any of this work without your generous support to help maintain your Church building and fingers crossed we will start work on this at the end of February. We have also applied for a grant to help with costs and we await the outcome. So we have another busy year of fundraising which we hope you will support.





February in the Garden

Prune shrubs that have finished flowering and finish pruning deciduous trees.

Prune hardy evergreen hedges and renovate deciduous hedges.

Cut back deciduous grasses left uncut over the winter.

Put a top dressing around plants after pruning, planting etc. such as bark or gravel around alpines. This helps to improve the soil, suppress weeds, insulate roots and retain moisture during the summer.

Apply a general fertiliser to all plants. Apply the fertiliser where the roots are - roughly a similar area to the spread of the branches.

Regularly check stored fruit and veg removing any rotting or mouldy specimens.

Regularly dead head plants and sweep up fallen debris, to prevent disease spreading.

Prune Trees Shrubs and climbers

It is ok to move established hedges, shrubs, trees and climbers and plant new specimens.

Continue to plant roses but remember not to plant them where previous roses have been to avoid replant disease.

Do not forget it is the last chance month for pruning apples and pears next month the sap will start moving. It is also time to cut autumn fruiting raspberry, black currents down to the ground to stimulate new canes.

Did you know? Mole activity increases in February as it is the mating season and they are building nests.

TOP TIP

Check whether pots and other containers need watering - even at this time of year they can dry out.

- The Parish Council agreed to sign an agreement with Westmorland and Furness Council for the siting of a memorial bench in Armathwaite, in memory of local resident Billy Robley.
- Updates were received on issues at the development at Gillian's Well, Calthwaite. The Parish Council also engaged a contractor to repair damage to the wall, who has completed repairs to a high standard.
- Repairs to the Coronation Bench at Plumpton have now been completed.
- The Community Governance Review into Parishes by Westmorland and Furness Council was discussed. The Parish Council have agreed that a review of wards in the Parish was warranted, with a proposal to extend these from three to five, retaining the same overall number of Councillors.
- The Precept for 2026/2027 was agreed, with a 4% increase, to cover increasing costs and ensure appropriate reserves are maintained. The annual Precept for Hesket Parish will now be £16,120.17, meaning a Band D property will pay around £15.36 a year towards the Parish Council.
- The Parish Council agreed to object to a planning application at High Hesket, for the erection of a further 25 bungalows.

A report of the 13th January meeting will be published in the next edition of the magazine.

Armathwaite Play Area

The Parish Council recently conducted a number of repairs at Armathwaite Play Area. The Council was very disappointed to receive a report that a number of fence planks have been removed from the play area fencing. Parents are reminded that they are responsible for their children's action at the play area. Repairs will now have to be carried out again, at further cost to the Parish Council, and ultimately residents.
