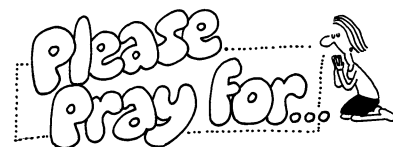
**The Bible Course** is coming in February, details in Unity and look out for the posters in church and online. **Please sign up to order your course guide.**
