Many of you spoke to Julie last Sunday, when there was no sign that she was unwell. She was taken ill on Tuesday and, despite the best efforts of the surgeons, died on Wednesday. Please pray for Julie's family and those who loved her as we all come to terms with this enormous shock.

We have a fabulous band of volunteers who help out with deliveries, collections and sorting food so it's running really well currently.
