Music at our Eucharistic services - as part of thinking about how we can make our worship more engaging and accessible, last year we trialled a different and more simple tune for the gloria. From next Sunday we will try adding some additional musical elements into the eucharistic prayer. We have chosen a simple tune which is repeated for both sung elements. We will try this for a few weeks and review how it is going, so do share your feedback with Christie or the wardens.
