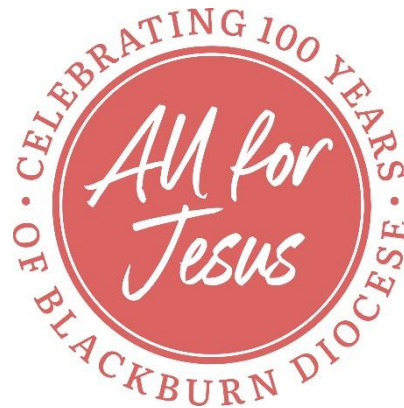


DONATIONS TO CHURCH FUNDS – Plate, card reader by the door or bank transfer.
