

## **In This Week's Scripture...**

**“Then Peter said in reply, ‘Look, we have left everything and followed you. What then will we have?’ ”**

Matthew 19: 27

*Today in Epiphanytide we remember and celebrate the conversion of S. Paul. Epiphany is a time when we reflect on the ways the Love that was given to us at Christmas is revealed in our lives and our surroundings. The ways that God continuously reveals to us the depths and mystery of his grace and love.*

*When we remember S. Paul, we think of a man who was already a believer, but who, in this revelation, encountered the Lord in a new way, and experienced a conversion of heart.*

*A conversion of heart that saw the grace and freedom and wideness of imagination of the Love of Jesus – calling us to cross divides and bridges, to take new risks, to find deeper trust. Your own conversion journey may not be one of blinding light and the Voice of God himself, but perhaps a gentler journey of realisation and encounter, of imagination and possibility. Can you remember when you first started to believe? What new encounter might we have if we re-open our hearts today?*
