Week of Prayer for Christian Unity | 18th January—25th January

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity falls between two dates that are connected by two feasts: 18th January is the feast of the Chair of St. Peter; and 25th January is the Conversion of St. Paul. The former is a feast celebrated mostly in the Roman Catholic Church, whereas the latter is a feast shared wider in the worldwide Church. Fixing a week of prayer between these two apostles is auspicious, as they had their own difficulties to overcome as they worked for the life of the Kingdom. And so we hold them and the example they offer before us as we pray for our brothers and sisters throughout the world, seeking the forgiveness of God for our part in the divisions, and committing ourselves to work together to reveal the love of God to the world around us.

Eternal God and Father, whose Son at supper prayed that his disciples might be one as he is one with you: draw us closer to him, that in common love and obedience to you we may be united to one another in the fellowship of the one Spirit, that the world may believe that he is Lord, to your eternal glory; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
