Breathe. Sometimes we can find it hard to get space to stop, take a deep breath and rest in the presence of God.

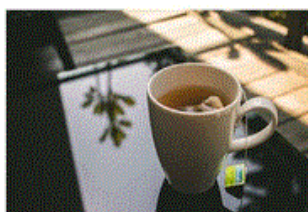
