

Hearing Loop Problem

Apologies to those who rely on the church's hearing loop system and who have experienced problems in recent weeks receiving a clear T- position signal. We are told that those who use the system can experience anything from no sound, a crackling sound, intermittent clarity, or a combination of all three! We can see no problem with the loop system in the office. A specialist engineering company has been invited to come to St John's and hopefully sort out the problem. This should take place in the next few days.

Please bear with the situation, however frustrating it must be for those dependent on the loop system. Meanwhile, if possible, please consider using the hearing aid in the normal mode and not the T mode.

St John's Lent Course 2026
