

Week of Christian Unity

18th-25th January

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (WPCU) is an ecumenical celebration which provides an opportunity to focus our prayers on Christian unity and to know that we are joining with international siblings in Christ. This year WPCU takes Ephesians 4 v 1-13 as its central text which includes the words “There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling.” (Ephesians 4:4).



We will be celebrating together with Churches Together in Camborne at **Revive Church on Wednesday 22nd January, with a service at 7pm**. Everyone is very welcome and we hope to see many of you there.


