Blessed Chalk

If you haven't done so already, you are encouraged to take a piece of chalk - blessed last Sunday in advance of the Feast of the Epiphany - with which to mark the lintel of your front door (or porch step) as follows:

20 + C + M + B + 26

[CMB being the abbreviation for the Latin phrase *Christus mansionem benedicat*, ("May Christ bless the house"), as well as the initials of the traditional names of the Magi: Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar.]

As Epiphany is a traditional time for the blessing of houses, Fr Peter would be delighted if you wish to contact him to arrange a more formal house blessing.
