### **First Reading** *Isaiah 49:3. 5-6*

The Lord promises that his Messiah will be formed in the womb and bring light and salvation to the ends of the earth.

### **Second Reading** *1 Corinthians 1:1-3*

Paul, with his apostolic authority, greets the church in Corinth, reminding them of their vocation to holiness.

### **Gospel** *John 1:29-34*

John the Baptist greets Christ as the lamb of God, and tells how he saw the Holy Spirit descend and rest on Jesus, the Messiah.
