

INTERIM INSIGHTS: Ask and It Will Be Given

Praying for Growth in 2026



Sometimes my wife will ask me, "Can you go to the shops and get some food?" Although I'm more than capable of restocking the fridge and cupboards, if I'm left to guess, I could come back with all sorts of things, missing out on the items we actually need! I need to know exactly what we need. **Specificity matters.** When

we know exactly what to ask for, we can act with confidence and we see the results we hoped for.

Prayer works in much the same way. **God wants us to ask Him clearly, not vaguely.** Sometimes we hesitate to pray specifically, worried: What if God doesn't answer? But faith grows when we ask boldly. Seeing answers, big or small, strengthens our trust in Him. General prayers can feel safe, but bold, specific prayers invite God to move in real, visible ways.

As we look ahead to 2026, let's pray specifically for growth in our churches:

- **St John the Baptist:** Average Sunday attendance at The Fountain is about 40 adults and children. **What if we prayed for an increase of 10?** Could our average reach 50 by the end of the year?
- **St Peter's:** Average attendance is about 20-25. **Let's pray for an increase of 5.** How faith-building would it be to see this rise to 25-30 by the end of 2026?

As we endeavour to grow spiritually as churches, we also recognise the need to grow numerically. **Let's step out in faith and pray bold, specific prayers for 2026** and watch how God answers!
