Safeguarding Training – a notice to all volunteers

We have received information from the Diocese safeguarding team that our parishioners may be receiving Basic Awareness Training Renewal Reminders from the training portal.

Unfortunately as the training portal is run by the **National Church of England, not the Diocese**, the diocese does not have control over these reminders.

The majority of our volunteers are required to undertake Foundation Training after completing Basic Awareness and the Diocese only requires that the highest level of training is renewed every three years.

If you do receive a Basic Awareness Training Renewal Reminder please check with our Safer Recruitment Officer to make sure it is required. As training records are kept on a secure database, Janet will not be able to respond to individual queries on a Sunday; if you need clarification please email via the Parish email saintmaryssouthgate@gmail.com.

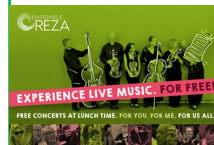
