Benefice Request for Parish Share

Thanks to your weekly / monthly planned giving, our Treasurers' are able to budget and plan our finances and the Benefice PCCs can make informed decisions about our ongoing commitments.

Part of our ongoing commitment is towards our Parish Share which enables work to continue through our Parish Churches as well as having the Diocesan Parish Support team there to help and guide. Examples in during 2025 included:

- legal support and advice regarding Churchyard Regulations
- legal support and guidance concerning the access to Horsford churchyard
- Finance team support for our Treasurer's Kerry and David
- Safeguarding support for our Benefice Safeguarding Officer and ongoing safeguarding training for PCC members and those involved in our Toddler Group team, Board Games and Art Club social
- AWA support and training
- APA training resources
- Repairs to The Rectory
- A full time incumbent

2025 Request: The Benefice contributed £23,017 (67%)

- Felthorpe: £4,800 (52%)
- Hevingham £1,275 (100%)
- Horsford £16,942 (71%)

2026 Request: £35,808 (4% increase)

The Benefice has received an amazing £43,695 subsidy from the Diocese, for which we're thankful.

The PCCs have agreed the request will be divided as follows:

- Felthorpe £9,672 (equivalent to £806 per month)
- Hevingham £1,326 (equivalent to £110.50 per month)
- Horsford £24,810 = (equivalent to £2,067.50 per month)

Monthly commitments agreed:

- Felthorpe £350
- Hevingham £50
- Horsford £1,000

All the PCCs remain committed to ensuring as much of the Parish Share is met even with the increasing utility and insurance costs. During 2026, you will be kept informed with how we're progressing with our contributions as well as what the current income and other expenditure is amounting to.
