The **Women's Group** is on Thursday, 9:00am at the Limes Centre Small Hall (IG7 5LP).




- ✝ *St Winifred's:* please remember Andy in your prayers. We also pray for any other members of the church community who are unwell or struggling.


AROUND THE CHURCHES
