



Draw Near Life giving habits for Lent 2026



As you may know I have just had my first cataract operation. It is amazing how much I had accepted as 'normal' my blurred and slightly opaque sight. As I now compare the sight from each eye, I have rediscovered colour and brightness around me and a clearer view of TV and people! I now can't wait for the 2nd eye to be addressed. In life we all become accustomed to things being 'normal' as they are, without perhaps noticing how habits or routines have slipped, or our priorities have been dampened by tiredness or routine.

This Lent we are being given the chance to stop and have a fresh look at ourselves, our faith and life with God. In the material being shared with us by the national Church at the invitation of the Archbishops we are called to **draw near** to God so he can draw near to us. This will be by renewing and **refreshing our habits** regarding those things which are essential to being a Christian.

Through the 6 weeks of Lent we will be encouraged to thinking about how we are called to share in worship; in prayer; in scriptures; in communion; in service and in sharing the good news. I hope that each one of us will find time and space to do this either alone or with others.

On your own you can join in **daily reflections** (the booklet will be available in Church for each household) – or you can follow online or on social media. There is also a **children's booklet** with a daily activity in Lent reflecting on the theme, you can find out more online.

In the Parish you will be able to join us in reflecting on this theme and material each week. There will be **opportunities to explore with others** after the **Tuesday Mass at St Faith's (9.30am)** or with the

Fellowship on **Wednesday after the Noon Mass at St Mary's** or on a **Saturday over a light breakfast at 9am at St Mary's**. If you would be interested in a group – but **if these times do not work for you** – please contact one of the Ministry Team and we will see what can be arranged.
