**R: I will confess my transgressions to the

Happy are they to whom the Lord imputes no  
guilt,

and in whose spirit there is no guile! **R**  
While I held my tongue, my bones withered  
away,

because of my groaning all day long.

For your hand was heavy upon me day and  
night;

my moisture was dried up as in the heat of sum-  
mer. **R**

Then I acknowledged my sin to you,  
and did not conceal my guilt.

I said, 'I will confess my transgressions to the  
Lord';

then you forgave me the guilt of my sin. **R**

Therefore all the faithful will make their prayers  
to you in time of trouble;

when the great waters overflow, they shall not reach them.

You are my hiding-place;  
you preserve me from trouble;  
you surround me with shouts of deliverance. **R**  
'I will instruct you and teach you  
in the way that you should go;  
I will guide you with my eye.  
Do not be like horse or mule,  
which have no understanding;  
who must be fitted with bit and bridle,  
or else they will not stay near you.' **R**  
Great are the tribulations of the wicked;  
but mercy embraces those who trust in the Lord.  
Be glad, you righteous, and rejoice in the Lord;  
shout for joy, all who are true of heart. **R**
