



## **Lent courses**

It's not too late to participate in a Lent course!

This year there are two Lent discussion groups running in the Cluster.

Rev. Rosheen is leading a 4-part course on Mondays at 7.30pm on The Psalms – Prayers of the Heart. Each week will examine a different Psalm, so it does not matter if you have missed the first session.

The venue for this course will change as the season progresses, so check the poster opposite for dates and venues.

### ***“Come and See” – Treslothan Church’s Lent Group***

At the beginning of John’s Gospel, Jesus invites the disciples to “come and see” in response to their question about where he is staying. The two disciples follow Jesus back to his home and spend the rest of the day with him. We don’t know what they talked about, but whatever it was, it was enough to convince the disciple Andrew, that Jesus was the promised Messiah. He went and said to his brother Simon, “Come and see who we have met”.

Our Lent Course for 2026 invites us to spend time with Jesus, to rest and relax in his presence as together we listen to his voice speaking to us through Scripture.

We will meet in the Village Hall on six consecutive Thursday evenings from 7.30pm, starting on Thursday, 19 February (the day after Ash Wednesday), and continuing on 26 Feb, 5 March, 12 March, 19 March and 26 March. Each session will close with tea, coffee and cake/biscuits and will finish promptly at 9pm.

It will help if we can attend all the sessions, but please come to as many as possible, even if you can’t make them all. This is not an academic course, nor is it Biblical analysis or anything like that, and it’s certainly not a test! It’s an opportunity to get to know Jesus better by spending time in his presence.

There is a course book which will be available to purchase at the discounted price of £9, but again, please don’t let this prevent you from joining the course. We will ensure that you can take part whether or not you have a copy of the book.
