


Last Year's Palm Crosses

The words to the left, by Reinhold Niebuhr (1892-1971), are probably familiar to many of us. But I think it's also worth reflecting on the rest of the prayer:

as it is, not as I would have it;
trusting that He will make all things right
if I surrender to His Will;
