
Baptism Welcome

Jesus, Lord, have mercy.



May Almighty God who sent his Son into the world to save sinners, bring us his pardon and his peace, now and forever.



The Temptations of Jesus



Reader - Luke 4: 2-4

Jesus... ..was led by the Spirit in wilderness
² where for forty days he was tempted by the devil.
He ate nothing at all during those days, and when
they were over, he was famished. ³ The devil said to
him, 'If you are the Son of God, command this stone
to become a loaf of bread.' ⁴ Jesus answered him,
'It is written, 'One does not live by bread alone.'

⁵ Then the devil led him up and showed him in an instant all the kingdoms of the world. ⁶ And the devil said to him, ‘To you I will give their glory and all this authority; for it has been given over to me, and I give it to anyone I please. ⁷ If you, then, will worship me, it will all be yours.’

¹⁶ When he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, he went to the synagogue on the Sabbath Day, as was his custom. He stood up to read, ¹⁷ and the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was given to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written:

¹⁸ ‘The Spirit of the Lord is upon me
because he has anointed me
to bring good news to the poor.

He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives
and recovery of sight to the blind,
to let the oppressed go free’.



in one body by the cross.




