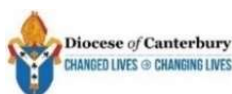

St Giles Church in Tonge is a grade 1 listed building on the 'At Risk Register'. As a Parish we are delighted to announce that we have received a grant of £15,105 from Archbishops Council from their 'Buildings for Mission Grants Fund', to carry out essential works to Tonge Church as identified by their Architect. This represents 90% of the total cost.

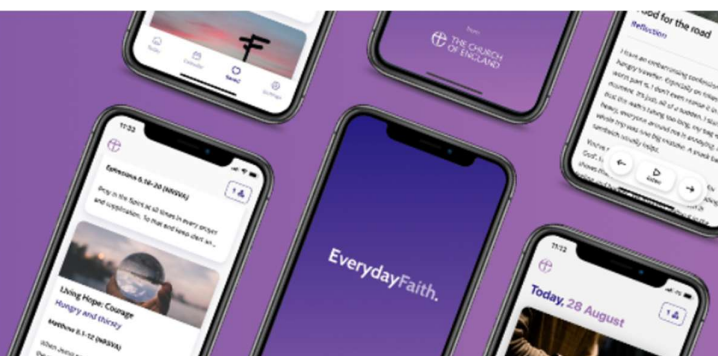
