Why attend an Ash Weds service?

Every year the season of Lent begins with Shrove Tuesday followed by Ash Wednesday. However, if you have never attended an Ash Wednesday service you may not know its significance. Lent is a time of fasting and penitence before celebrating Good Friday and Easter Sunday. Ash Wednesday gives us all the opportunity to begin Lent with lament. We can lament the state of the world and we can lament our own inability to live as God's children. The service is an opportunity for confessing, to remember we are made of the dust of the earth but also to seek God's forgiveness and be reminded that we're destined for glory.

Each person is marked with a cross of ash on the forehead and will be encouraged on their journey of faith. As Christ's baptised followers we need his help and forgiveness, and this is a visible reminder of his claim on our lives. So consider coming to one of the two Ash Wednesday services taking place in the Cluster as way to begin your Lent this year.

Lent courses

The season of Lent is fast approaching!

Ash Wednesday is on 18th February, marked with a service of ashing at Camborne Church at 10am and Crowan Church at 7pm.

This year there are two Lent discussion groups running in the Cluster.

Rev. Rosheen will lead a 4-part course on Mondays at 7.30pm on The Psalms – Prayers of the Heart. The venue for this course will change as the season progresses, so check the poster overleaf for dates and venues.

“Come and See” – Treslothan Church’s Lent Group

At the beginning of John’s Gospel, Jesus invites the disciples to “come and see” in response to their question about where he is staying. The two disciples follow Jesus back to his home and spend the rest of the day with him. We don’t know what they talked about, but whatever it was, it was enough to convince the disciple Andrew, that Jesus was the promised Messiah. He went and said to his brother Simon, “Come and see who we have met”.

Our Lent Course for 2026 invites us to spend time with Jesus, to rest and relax in his presence as together we listen to his voice speaking to us through Scripture.

We will meet in the Village Hall on six consecutive Thursday evenings from 7.30pm, starting on Thursday, 19 February (the day after Ash Wednesday), and continuing on 26 Feb, 5 March, 12 March, 19 March and 26 March. Each session will close with tea, coffee and cake/biscuits and will finish promptly at 9pm.

It will help if we can attend all the sessions, but please come to as many as possible, even if you can’t make them all. This is not an academic course, nor is it Biblical analysis or anything like that, and it’s certainly not a test! It’s an opportunity to get to know Jesus better by spending time in his presence.

There is a course book which will be available to purchase at the discounted price of £9, but again, please don’t let this prevent you from joining the course. We will ensure that you can take part whether or not you have a copy of the book.
