Psalm 2

R: You are my Son; this day have I begotten you.

Why are the nations in an uproar?

Why do the peoples mutter empty threats?

Why do the kings of the earth rise up in revolt
and the princes plot together,

against the Lord and against his anointed? **R**

'Let us break their yoke', they say;

'let us cast off their bonds from us.'

He whose throne is in heaven is laughing;

the Lord has them in derision. **R**

Then he speaks to them in his wrath and his

rage fills them with terror. 'I myself have set my
king upon my holy hill of Zion.'

Let me announce the decree of the Lord:

he said to me, 'You are my Son;

this day have I begotten you. **R**

Ask of me and I will give you the nations

for your inheritance

and the ends of the earth for your possession.

You shall crush them with an iron rod

and shatter them like a piece of pottery.' **R**

And now, you kings, be wise;
be warned, you rulers of the earth.
Submit to the Lord with fear,
and with trembling bow before him;
Lest he be angry and you perish;
for his wrath is quickly kindled.
Happy are they all who take refuge in him! **R**

R He spoke to them out of the pillar of cloud.

The Lord is king; let the people tremble;
he is enthroned upon the cherubim;
let the earth shake. The Lord is great in Zion;
he is high above all peoples.
Let them confess his name, which is great and
awesome; he is the Holy One. **R**
'O mighty King, lover of justice,
you have established equity; you have executed
justice and righteousness in Jacob.'
Proclaim the greatness of the Lord our God
and fall down before his footstool;
he is the Holy One. **R**
Moses and Aaron among his priests, and
Samuel among those who call upon his name,
they called upon the Lord and he answered them.
He spoke to them out of the pillar of cloud;
they kept his testimonies
and the decree that he gave them. **R**
'O Lord our God, you answered them indeed;
you were a God who forgave them,
yet punished them for their evil deeds.'
Proclaim the greatness of the Lord our God
and worship him upon his holy hill;
for the Lord our God is the Holy One. **R**
