
ST MARY'S, KELVEDON - PUDDING & WINE TASTING ON SATURDAY 7TH MARCH @ 7 P.M.


WORLD DAY OF PRAYER - FRIDAY 6TH MARCH AT ST MARY IMMACULATE RC @ 2 P.M.


