Sunday 15th February 2026 – 10.00am – Show the Love

February is here again, and 'Show the Love' is celebrated on 14th February each year. It's easy to remember alongside Valentine's Day! For more than a decade, The Climate Coalition has united communities behind the power of green hearts. 'Show The Love' has encouraged public support for climate action through local events, heartfelt conversations and green heart craftivism all over the country, not least in St John's where we have a lot of nature and green space to care about. Working together makes our case much stronger.

We are asked to:

- share what we love about nature on social media with the hashtag #ShowTheLove
- write to our councillors and MPs to gently remind them of the strength of our feelings, ideally with a small green heart gift. Last year we had a lovely email thanking us for the green heart card we emailed to our MP and a personal visit from him to St John's Wednesday drop-in where he also expressed interest in our silver Eco Church award.
- put on a display to explain the need for action and what can be done for a positive impact
- get involved in protecting our green spaces – so important for our mental health as well as for nature to thrive.

Are you interested in being confirmed?

We don't yet have an exact date for the Confirmation Service in Wakefield Cathedral but will confirm this as soon as we can. It may be held at Easter on Saturday 4th April 2026.

If you are an adult or a young person (of secondary school age), and are interested in being confirmed, please contact Stephanie on (01924 371029 or stephanie.buchanan@btinternet.com). If you have not been baptized, there will be the opportunity to be baptized and confirmed in the confirmation service. At St John's we are holding a series of confirmation preparation sessions for adults and will be starting another one for young people soon. The sessions will explore the key beliefs of the Christian faith with a focus on what it means to follow Jesus in practice. The sessions will include plenty of time for discussion, as well as the chance to learn from the Bible, the Christian tradition and the experience of Christians.

Giving to St John's

If you feel able to give, you can support St John's financially in the following ways:

Church Services - We do not take up a collection during services, but there is a box at the back of church for cash donations. Gift Aid envelopes are available so that we can recover Gift Aid on 'one-off' donations. There is also a card reader at the back of church.

Standing Orders – will continue as before.

Stewardship Envelopes – We have weekly or monthly envelopes for giving by cash or cheque. If you pay tax, we can recover Gift Aid on your giving. Please see Geoff Lockyer.

The Parish Giving Scheme – This is like a standing order, but the regular payments from your bank account go to PGS, who pass it on to the church. For taxpayers, they also recover the Gift Aid, so it reduces our admin and improves our cashflow.

A further advantage of the PGS is that you can opt to have your regular gift increased annually in line with inflation, which can help it keep up with increasing costs without having to keep changing your standing order, calculating an annual top-up or putting an extra coin in your envelope every week.
