
Woodkirk Walkers

The Electoral Roll Annual Update 2026

The electoral roll records those who are entitled to vote at the APCM (Annual Parish Church Meeting) which selects the PCC (Parochial Church Council). Candidates for election to the PCC must have been on the roll for at least 6 months before the APCM at which they offer themselves for election to the PCC. If you are baptized, at least 16 years old, and regard yourself as a member of our worshipping community, joining the electoral roll is a good way to record that membership.
