Eco Tip of the week

Switch off Power for Earth Hour

This Saturday (28th March) show your solidarity for the planet this Earth Hour and switch off at 8:30pm!

1. Take a break from electricity -

Consider spending a little more time doing low carbon activities such as reading, sport, going for a walk or playing games and keep away from TV, laptops and shopping. These small breaks in add up and help to reduce your carbon footprint.

2. Travel Green - Give your car time off when you can and consider lower carbon alternatives. Each mile in a car produces 290gCO₂e, travelling a mile by train therefore saves 218gCO₂e, whilst each mile walked or cycled produces zero. Next time you pop out, try to leave the car behind and walk, cycle or lift share to do your bit for the environment.
