Thursday, 2nd April, 7.00 pm : Maundy Thursday - Mass of the last supper followed by The Watch in the Lady Chapel until 9.00 pm

Friday, 3rd April, 2.15 pm : Stations of the Cross
3.00 pm : Good Friday : Celebration of the Lord's Passion

Sunday, 5th April, 3.00 pm : Mass for Easter Sunday : The resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Renewal of our Baptism vows.

The solemn procession with the palms is the traditional start of Palm Sunday, the first liturgy of Holy Week, the most solemn week in the Church's year. Mass begins with the Collect.

SIGN OF PEACE : Lord Jesus Christ, you looked with love on the holy city of Jerusalem, and with tears in your eyes, you said, 'If only you understood the message of peace. But, alas, it is hidden from your eyes,'. Look with pity on our world, torn asunder by war and strife, and grant that all of God's children may enjoy the peace and unity of your kingdom, where you live for ever and ever.

Lord, remember not only your people of good will but also people of ill will.
Do not remember only the sufferings, that have been inflicted on us, but remember too the fruit we have bought as a result of this suffering:
the comradeship of loyalty,
the humility and courage,
the generosity and greatness of heart that has grown out of it.
And when they come to judgement, let all the fruits that we have borne be their forgiveness.
