HAMBLEDON



We hope to have a donkey or pony for the procession. **Wednesday 1 April 9.30am** Holy Communion, Rev Liz will be presiding. **Thursday 2 April. 7pm:** Service of Communion with the washing of feet - a very evocative service reminding us of the Last Supper. **Good Friday:** The Walk of witness leaves Stewarts Green at 1000 stopping at the village hall, bottom of the High Street and up to the Church for hot cross buns. Rev Ruth Schofield is leading a reflective service of the cross at 2pm. **Easter Sunday:** Join us for the wonderful Dawn Service at 6am as we bless the Easter candle and the Easter fire and feel the joy of Jesus’ resurrection. Bacon sarnies on completion and news of Toby and Richard’s progress on their 100+ mile kayak race. The main **Easter Communion** is at 1100. The choir has been preparing some anthems for Easter.
