**\*Cleaning Kit:** suggest 'J Cloths' on a roll from Tesco, Green and Blue (Roll is 40 items). Take one of each colour, fold separately, put into small, clear plastic bag with handles, along with half of a green 'Scotch Brite' cleaner. [These come in packs of 3].

**\*\*Toilet Roll:** suggest 3 ply, 12 pack Saxon Softest Toilet Tissue (pink and blue packaging) from ALDI. These are double rolls.

**NB** Any other useful (but acceptable) items you may think of:- toilet cleaner; kitchen towel also toiletries :-soap; shampoo; conditioner; shower/bath gel; toothbrush(es);toothpaste; razor etc.
