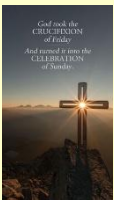

A Prayer for Easter Day: Lord of life and power, who through the mighty resurrection of your Son overcame the old order of sin and death to make all things new in him: grant that we, being dead to sin and alive to you in Jesus Christ, may reign with him in glory. Lord, we praise you in this Easter season. Change our lives, change our hearts to be messengers of Easter joy and hope. May the glory of Jesus's resurrection remind us that with You, nothing is impossible or without hope. He is risen indeed. Alleluia!
