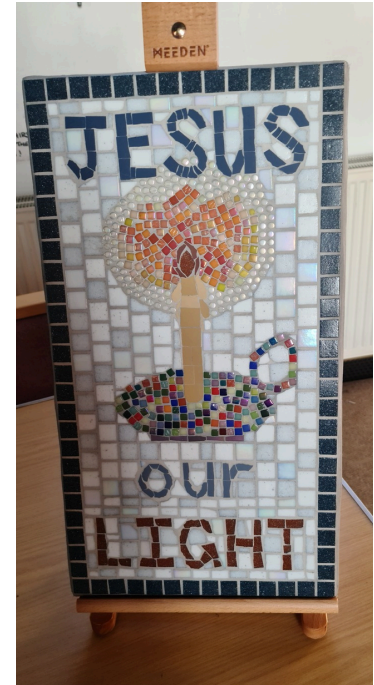

**YOUNG AT HEART** are an over 50's group who meet weekly on a Tuesday, between 10am and 12pm for refreshments and a chat. It is great to share happy times with friends. Equally the adage that a trouble shared is a trouble halved is very true. Smiles and friendly ears await.

**REFILL** Fridays 9am to 10.30am termtime, is a group for parents or carers to come and relax with a tea or coffee, have a biscuit or two and chat. Toys and space provided for preschoolers.

The Pantry still works closely with our local community and other community groups to provide a Food Bank to those in need in our area.

# Life Groups

## What are Life Groups?

Life Groups are small gatherings that meet during the week to build community, explore faith, and support one another in everyday life.

They are a place to: Read and reflect on the Bible, Pray together, Share life honestly, Encourage one another in faith. Life Groups are where church becomes personal – where we are known, supported, and able to grow.

## Getting involved

We encourage everyone to be part of a Life Group. If you're not yet connected, speak to a leader or contact the church to find a group that fits.



## Why do they matter?

Life Groups are central to how we care for one another as a church.

They provide:

- Community - building real relationships
- Support - walking through life's challenges together
- Growth - deepening understanding of faith
- Belonging - ensuring no one is on their own

They are also places of joy – places to share meals, celebrate milestones, and enjoy time together throughout the year.
