*Looking ahead...* **Palm Sunday, 29<sup>th</sup> March** being the *fifth* Sunday this month, there will be a **Benefice Service** at **10.00am** in **St Andrew's, Newton Tony**. Weather permitting, those who are able will gather at the **Memorial Hall** (car park) and process with **Palm Crosses** to the church for the Service – please come and join in this Service, at the start of **Holy Week**

Looking further ahead... on **Good Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> April**, we plan to hold our 'traditional' **Good Friday Walk** starting at **11.00am** at **St Nicholas, Cholderton** and proceeding through the Bourne Valley, pausing at all the Churches en route, to reflect on the 'The Seven Last Words of Jesus on the Cross' with Bible readings, hymns and prayers. This event is particularly suitable for families, including well-controlled dogs, and remember to **bring a packed lunch**, which we stop and eat at Newton Tony, at approx. 12.00 noon, before continuing our walk, finishing at St Michael & All Angels, Winterbourne Earls at approx. 5.30pm, with tea, coffee and hot cross buns. You are welcome to join in at any stage, or stop after a few miles, as you wish. More details on the website, nearer the time...

**Lent** is an ideal time to remind ourselves of the value of spending time **reading the Bible**, and reflecting, prayerfully, on God's Word to us. It is often helpful to do so together in a group (not least because it encourages us to make the necessary commitment), but reading the Bible on our own is also a very good exercise.
