may reign with him in glory;  
to whom with you and the Holy Spirit  
be praise and honour, glory and might,  
now and in all eternity.

### Today's Readings

**First Reading Acts 10:34-43** Peter challenges the prevailing culture by witnessing to the truths of Christ's life, death and resurrection..

### Second Reading Colossians 3:1-4

In baptism, Paul reminds us, we already share in Christ's risen presence, God's redemptive pattern for transforming our lives.

### Gospel John 20:1-18

Drawn to the tomb, Peter is curious but unsatisfied, John observes then believes, and Mary Magdalene recognises, worships and witnesses to Christ's resurrection.
